# Purpose of this platform is to provide information and address questions

- \* Title I provides federal funding to schools to help students who are low achieving or at most risk of falling behind.
- \* Title I is allocated to schools based on the percentage of students receiving free/reduced lunch.
- \* Schools with a percentage of at least 40% are eligible for a schoolwide program. Schools at 75% must be funded.

# Salem-Keizer Public School District

In 2020-2021 Salem-Keizer School District will support:

- ❖ 4 Title IA Pre-schools
- ❖ 21 Title IA Elementary Schools
- ❖ 6 Title IA Middle Schools
- ❖ 3 Title IA High Schools
- ❖ 12 Title IA Private Schools

This is approximately 20,600 students or 49% of the total student population in the district.

# To be a Schoolwide School:

- The school must have a free/reduced lunch count of at least 40%.
- The school must collect and analyze data that effects student achievement.
- The school must develop a continuous improvement plan and annually review the effectiveness of the plan.
- *ALL Title I-A Schools in Salem-Keizer are Schoolwide Programs*

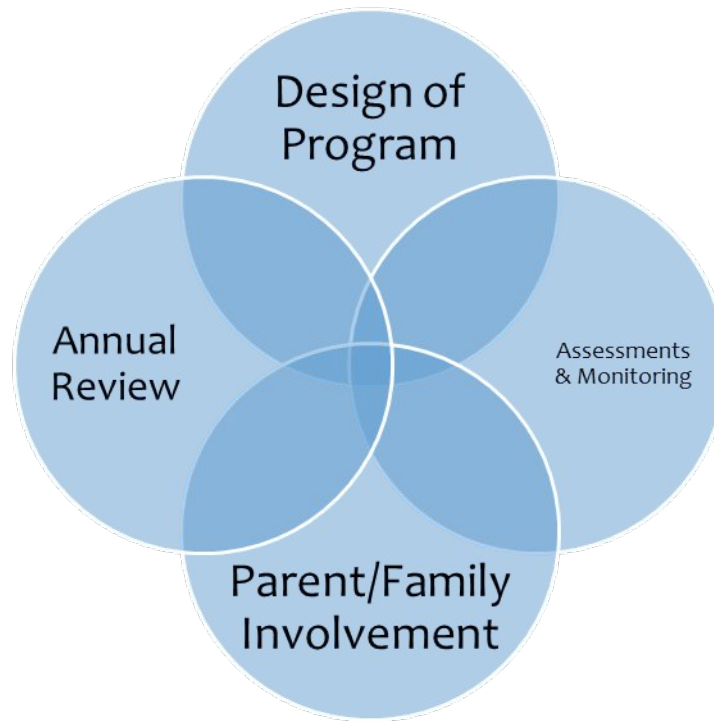
**Systems are in place to monitor, measure, and improve our students academically, socially, and emotionally by....**

- Continuing to utilize Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports for all students.
- Having weekly MTSS meetings to best support students with Tier 2 and 3 needs
